



GENERAL INFORMATION

Health Requirements

Official ID required (i.e. metal tag, registration tattoo with papers). Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) issued by an accredited veterinarian within 30 days prior to entry. Cattle from Michigan please call the Office of the State Veterinarian for special import requirements.

For more information please call Nebraska Department of Agriculture, Office of Animal Health at 800-572-2437. You can also refer to page 13 of the NALJA News for Health Requirements. Please make sure you have your veterinarian issue the proper health papers in regard to Nebraska requirements. Be sure that you meet requirements for states that you will be traveling through as well. State officials have the right to request health papers at any time. **Have your health papers in order and with the cattle.**

Check your Tattoos

Please check all tattoos prior to departing for Grand Island. Cattle **MUST** have legible tattoos that correctly match the animal's registration certificate. Re-tattooing at the show **WILL NOT BE ALLOWED. NO EXCEPTIONS!**

Stalling & Arrival

Cattle may begin arriving in tie-outs on Friday, June 30th. **ABSOLUTELY NO CATTLE OR TACK ALLOWED IN THE BARNS UNTIL SATURDAY, JULY 1st.** All junior cattle will be stalled by state. Please refer to NALJA Show Rules for complete stalling details. Cattle entered solely in the All American Limousin Futurity may not be stalled with junior show cattle. **Generators and porta coolers will not be allowed in the barns.**

Arrival at Grounds

When you arrive in Grand Island proceed to Gate 4 located on Stolley Park Road. A map of the grounds is included with this packet for reference.

Tie-Out & Bedding Material

Tie outs will be bedded with mulch prior to your arrival. Bedding fees will cover the first bedding in the barn and mulch for tie outs. Pens in tie-outs are allowed **ONLY** if you have cow/calf pairs, this is a Nebraska Fairgrounds rule and will be enforced.

No Dogs Allowed

Per Nebraska Fairground Rules no dogs are allowed on the grounds.

Check in Procedures

Check-in will start Sunday morning at 8:00 a.m. Heifers whose papers are stamped will just need to bring the stamped papers to the check-in area. Bulls and Steers will be directed to the scales after tattoos are read and scrotal measurements taken on bulls born before September 1, 2016. After your animals are

checked in you can pick up your shirts, check-in packets and review your satellite events at a designated area within the check-in area. **Please do not pick up packets or have animals weighed until your tattoos have been checked.**
